1 Walls are painted a soothing pale hue, **Benjamin Moore Gray Cashmere**.

2 **Windows** are unadorned to maximize light and views.

3 To connect to the home's natural setting, Perkins selected Athens Silver Cream **marble tile** by Ann Sacks in various sizes to sheath the floor, shower wall and ceiling, vanity backsplash, and tub surround.

4 The **brushed nickel shower head** has a touch pad on the outside wall that allows the homeowners to set their desired water temperature and flow. "When you get in the shower, you hit your setting and it's instantly ready," says Perkins.

5 The sizable shower has a **quartz bench** and a wonderful view through the glass enclosure to the lake.

6 A **ceramic garden stool** offers an attractive perch to place small items next to the tub.

7 The clean-lined **floating vanity** by Wetstyle is made of dark-stained wenge wood. "Three deep drawers offer storage," says Perkins.

8 The **trough sink** is a modern interpretation of a 19th-century rustic version.

9 Tall rectangular **Restoration Hardware mirrors** bounce light around the room.

10 **Sconces** by Hudson Valley repeat the angular shape of the mirror, sink, and vanity.
